### A Prayer for the Week:

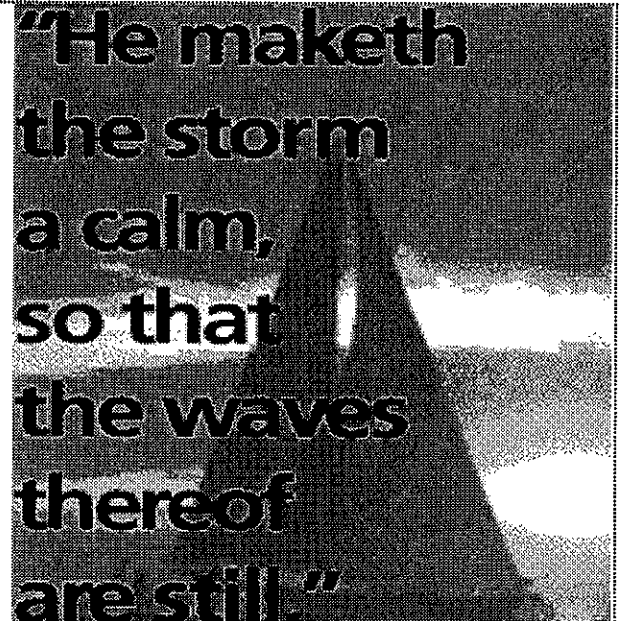
Lord Jesus, please take hold of us when we are afraid. Keep us from taking our eyes off you. Amen. (Matthew 14:29-31)

**“Take courage. Jesus is with you. Do not be afraid.”** Give your worries to Jesus in prayer.

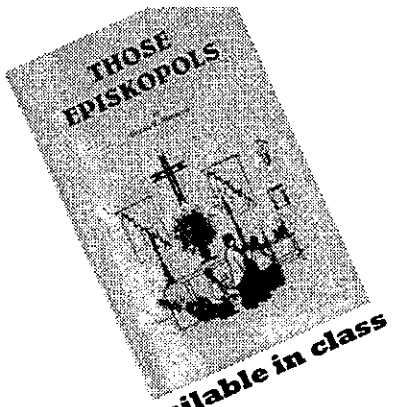
## SERVICE

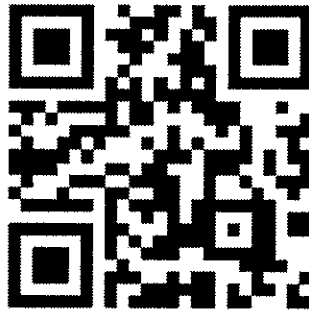

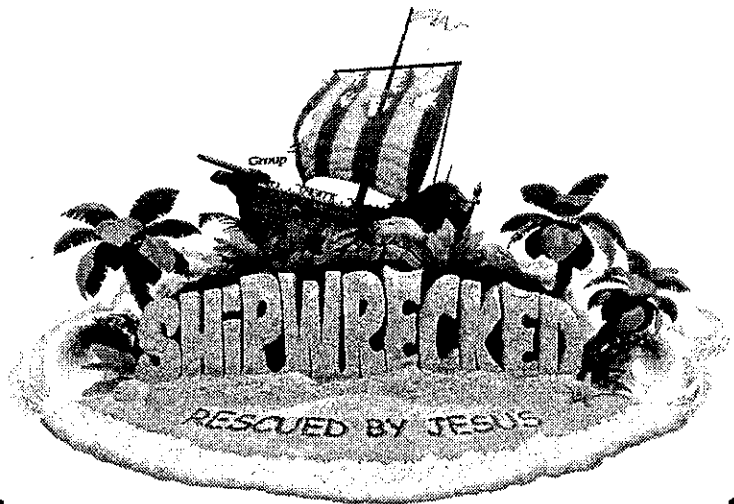

*For the last 8 weeks, the following letter has appeared in the bulletin. Because Fr. Marty and the vestry are concerned that some may not have read the back page of the letter, we reprint it below, but with the final paragraphs now in the front:*

---

*“St. Joseph’s has given me the independence to discover my own faith while still guiding me toward love and open-mindedness.” – Jasmin Jimenez/Senior Sermon Pentecost 2017*

The words above from graduating senior Jasmin for her Pentecost Senior Sermon exemplify one of the multitudinous ways that your financial giving is making a difference in the lives of many. With grateful hearts, the vestry, staff and I would like to once again say “Thank You” for entrusting us with your 2017 pledge to do God’s work here at Saint Joseph’s. What a gift you are to this community and beyond! Your faith continues to inspire and bless us in many ways, and we continue to lift you in a prayer of thanksgiving! I would like to update you on our current financial status:

**Anticipated 2018 Operating Income Shortfall** – We are all incredibly grateful for the additional sacrificial giving last year, which enabled us cover the operating income shortfall for this year’s budget. Your generosity enabled us to continue all of our important ministries, and again we thank you! However, as I reported at our annual meeting in January, the estate bequests and additional investment income that were not present last year to cover our deficit will not magically reappear for 2018. In short, we are in the same position now as we were at this time last year as we look towards next year. The vestry continues to do an amazing job at being prudent stewards of our financial resources. However, we can only cut operational expenses so much while maintaining our current staff of valued employees. We must look for the ways that we can increase our income in order to maintain the current staff and ministries for 2018:

**Increased Giving:** I am so grateful for so many of you who have stretched your sacrificial giving to reach and even exceed a tithe of 10%. Thank you! If you are currently not tithing, or have not been moving towards a 10% tithe, I ask you to prayerfully consider and plan to start to “step up” as we move towards 2018. If ½ our families moved towards tithing, we would not only overcome our anticipated shortfall, but we could also afford to fund the additional ministries we would like to offer.

**Increased Membership:** There is so much good that God is doing here, and yet we still seem to remain the best kept secret in town. Current research continues to show that the most common way for new people to join a church is through personal invitation from current church members. As we continue to pray about our own financial commitments, pray also that God will show us the opportunities to invite others to join us on this incredible journey of faith. Remember that increased members = increased pledges. There is room at the inn!

**2017 Budget** – Thanks to your continued pledge contributions, and the cost-efficiency focus of our vestry and staff, we are totally on target to meet our budget for 2017. As long as the pledge commitments we all made for 2017 are achieved, we will have income that meets our expenses

for the year. Please remember to keep your pledge up-to-date over the summer months. While many of us take some time to go away for summer vacations, the bills that we need to pay to keep the church running do not take a vacation.

**Cost Efficiencies and Effectiveness** – The vestry and staff continue to look for ways to become even better stewards of the financial resources entrusted to us for the ministries of our church. Our finance committee task force has been working tirelessly to improve the accuracy and timeliness of our financial reporting to you of your pledge contributions. In that regard, the vestry has approved the following change to our timing and method of our pledge status statements to the congregation:

**Timing of our pledge statement updates:** We will switch from a quarterly reporting system to a twice per year update. Beginning in June, the transmission of our pledge statements to the pledging members of the congregations will detail each person's contributions through May. A second update will be sent in November detailing each person's contributions through October. (It is still our intention to mail to each pledging family an end-of-year statement for your income tax purposes.)

**Emailing of our pledge statement updates:** Beginning with the June update for our pledges through May, we will switch to an email transmission of your pledge statement. Not only will this save considerable dollars in stamps and paper, it will also save a considerable amount of volunteer and staff time spent in printing, folding, labeling, stamping, and stuffing envelopes.

To accomplish this, we need to ensure that we have an up-to-date email account for each person/family who pledges. If you are currently receiving our Constant Contact weekly emails from the church, then your email address on file should be accurate. If you are not receiving our weekly emails, please contact Charlotte at the church office to add your preferred email to receive your pledge update communications (email: [charlotte@stjoesweb.org](mailto:charlotte@stjoesweb.org) or phone: 561-732-3060). (For those who do not have email, we will continue to mail your statements.)

Thank you for your continued generosity that enables us to bring youth group graduates like Jasmin, and young and old alike, into the fullness of God's family and nurture their spiritual development.

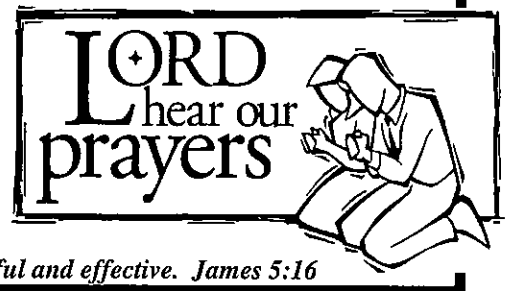
